Congress Passes Paycheck Protection Updates

On Wednesday, the Senate passed the <u>Paycheck Protection</u> <u>Flexibility Act of 2020 (H.R. 7010)</u> by voice vote. The House passed the bill last week by a vote of 417-1. The legislation extends the 8-week forgiveness period for the Paycheck Protection Payment (PPP) loan to 24 weeks and would require loan recipients to spend 60% of loan proceeds (rather than 75%) on payroll. The bill will now be sent to the President for his signature. Meanwhile, Congress is still grappling with negotiating the next round of COVID-19 stimulus funding.
